

## Pod Maturity at Whiteville on September 11

Note that Bailey and Sullivan are at optimum maturity now. We decided not to dig because the soil was dry and relatively hard and we were worried that high winds would blow dug peanuts around. Depending on the amount of rain we could lose a significant amount of yield if peanuts stay in the field for another 10-14 days due to pod shed. Those in the black category are poised to shed within 7-10 days.
