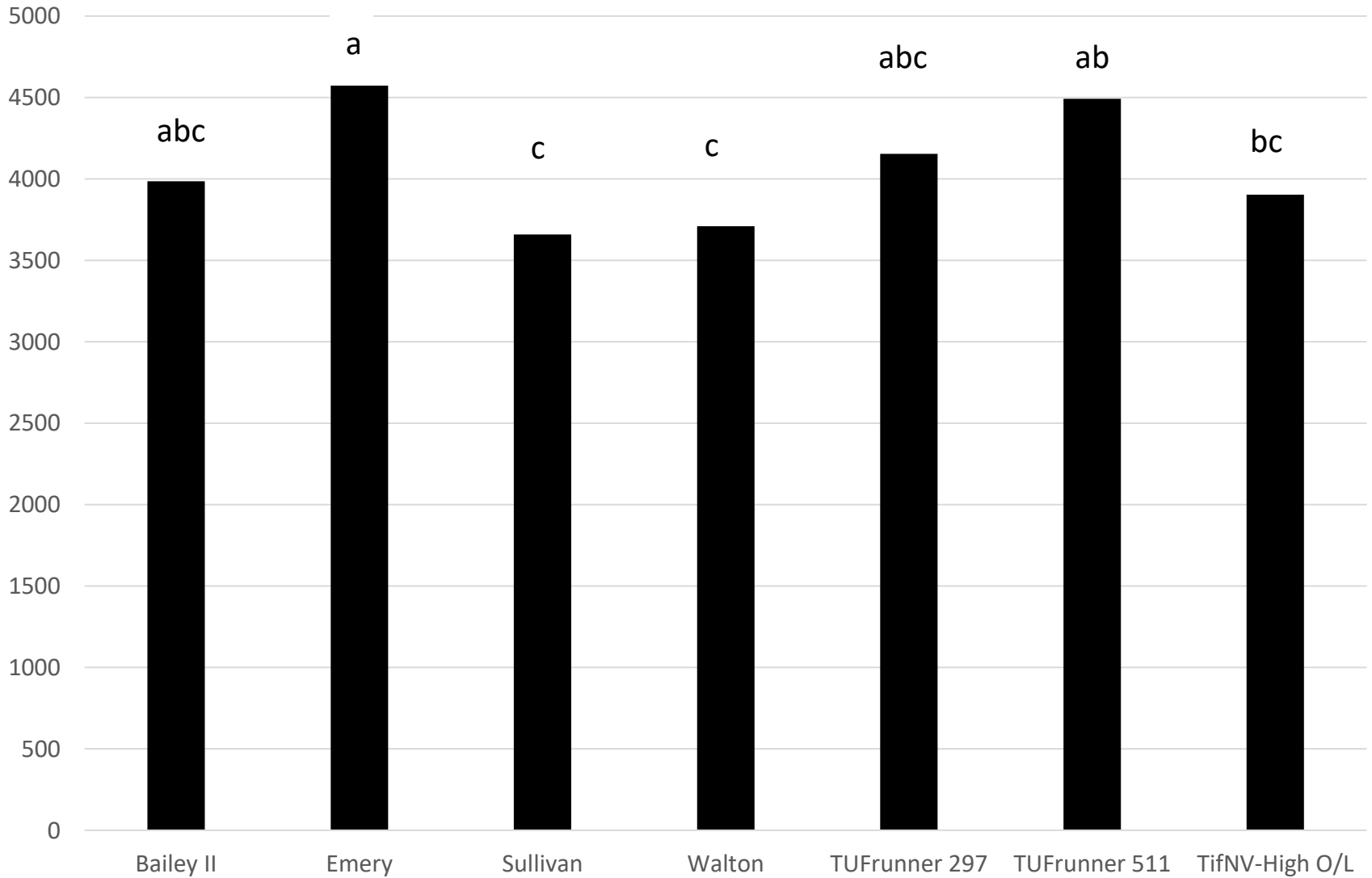

# Materials and Methods

- Small plots, 2 rows by 30 feet
- 4 replications
- Conventional tillage
- Virginia market types: Bailey II, Emery, Sullivan, and Walton
- Runner market types: TUFrunner 297, TUFrunner 511, and TifNV-High O/L
- Planting date: May 7
- Digging dates: Virginia market types October 5; Runner market types October 18

# Summary

- TUFrunner 297 and TUFrunner 511 yielded as well as Bailey II and Emery
- Yield was lower for Sullivan, Walton, and TifNV-High O/L compared with yield of Emery
- Yield of the runner market types TUFrunner 297, TUFrunner 511 and TifNV-High O/L was similar
- Runner market types were dug about two weeks later than Virginia market types
