



Peanut plant killed by *Aspergillus* crown rot.  
Characteristic sooty sporulation of the fungus at the crown,  
Spores can be seen here on stalks as small black pin-heads





Thimet (phorate) phytotoxicity on lower leaves is not harmful to the plant and does not adversely affect yield



Thrips injury





Early season tomato spotted wilt symptoms  
Stunting becomes more pronounced later on susceptible cultivars
