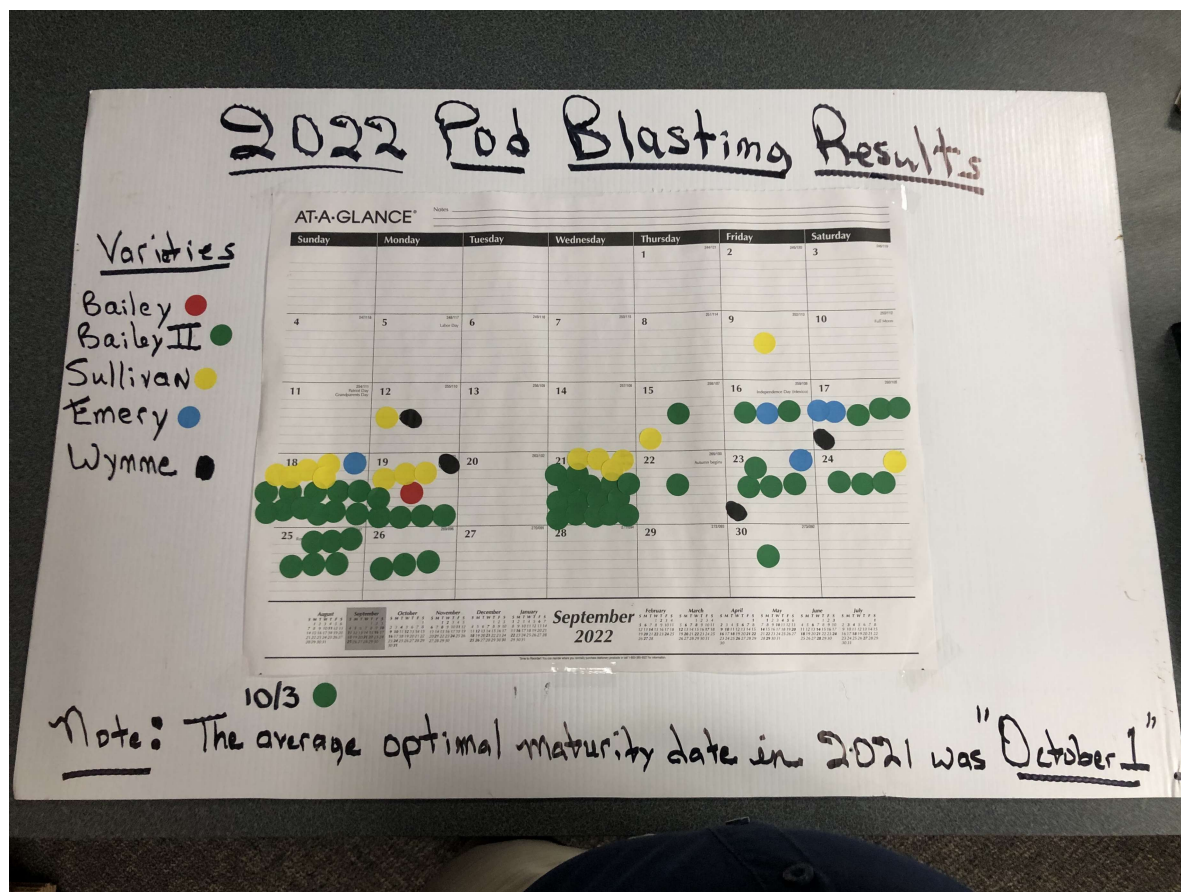

PITT PEANUT POD BLASTING RESULTS

(Week 1)

Based on the results of the first week of peanut pod blasting in Pitt County, a majority of our peanut fields will benefit from more time in order to reach optimal maturity. Based on the 83 samples that were evaluated at two sites, the week of September 18 - 24 will likely be a key week for digging. Listed below is a chart which shows a distribution of this week's samples and their projected maturity dates.



Each colored dot represents the estimated projected optimal maturity date for that sample. (September 2022)
