



Crop oil injury (above) vs. late leaf spot lesion (below); the underside of crop oil injury is smooth compared to LLS undersides which are bumpy from spore production







2,4-DB injury can look like a white spotting on the leaflet near the stem; this is transient and the peanut will grow out of it without negative impact on yield.

Velvetbean caterpillar moth in the canopy.
