



Leaf scorch is generally sporadic and not considered economic; this is caused by the same fungus that causes pepper spot (*Leptosphaerulina crassiaca*)

Thimet injury (below) can sometimes look similar but tends to exhibit a more regular spatial distribution in the canopy, as opposed to leaf scorch which is more here-and-there; Thimet injury usually has more lesions near the leaflet periphery
