Good morning NC Peanut Stakeholders, agents, specialists, etc.

FSA Planted Acres were released this week. I have attached the information analyzed by county and market type.

A few points...

- North Carolina is up 6,248 acres over last year.
- This data is from FSA and examines planted acres certified with FSA by growers to be eligible for receiving marketing assistance loans or loan deficiency payments.
- These acres reflect peanuts that were certified by the grower as being grown for Farmer Stock/Nut peanuts.
- I removed any acres certified as Green – this year, that number is 536 acres across Columbus, Brunswick, Pender, Pitt, Bladen, Edgecombe, Duplin, Sampson, Wilson, and Carteret counties (in that order).
- Congratulations to Martin County for taking the new lead as the top county by planted acres.
- We have almost 2,000 acres of Valencia's planted this year.

Let me know if you have any questions. More information, including maps, will be shared during our annual meeting/field day. I have also included an updated flyer for the September 5th meeting. Feel free to share if you know of others who are interested.
